

BEAR HUNT

Tatnall Camp is located west of the vast Chapleau Game Preserve and accessible by a scenic float plane ride. The black bear is one of the most challenging animals the hunter can encounter. Our bear hunting package is a combination fishing and hunting experience. We suggest hunts be booked well in advance.

The hunt takes place through accessing by boat the adjoining creeks, rivers and shoreline of Oba Lake as well as walking some distance to various hunt areas. The hunting area is suitable for both gun or archery hunters. Upon arrival at Camp, we will outline the bear areas on a topographical map and familiarize you with each bait site prior to your hunt. Two pre-baited sites are allocated for each hunter.

Spring Hunt 2024 - May 25-June 1, June 2-9 (2 Weeks)

Fall Hunt 2024 - September 1-7, September 8-15 (2 Weeks)

- Use of amenities including freezer service, bear hanging area, fish cleaning facility, outdoor barbecue grill, fish-fryers, bonfire pits
